Itinerary

Day 1: Saturday morning will be devoted to theory and set up of camera systems. In the afternoon you will take two photography dives and return to Snorkel Inn for a critique of your photos.

Day 2: On Sunday morning there will be one dive and then back to Snorkel Inn for a critique of your photos and certification presentation.

Essentials

- You will need to have your own underwater camera system including housing.
- You must have your Open Water Diver certification.
- You will require your own scuba gear and snorkelling kit. If you do not already own your own equipment, scuba gear is available for hire.
