Rescue Diver Essentials

- As a Rescue Diver you must have your own snorkel and safe diver kit including but not limited to: mask, snorkel, fins, boots, gloves, safety signal tube, whistle, slate, torch and knife
- You must also have your Open Water Diver certification, a current First Aid certificate, and either Navigation Specialty or Advanced Adventurer certification.
